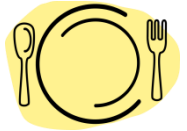

Dear Parents/carers and children,

SCHOOL LUNCHES

School meals are available to order via ParentPay, for ALL weeks, right up to the Easter holidays. Please keep track of your orders to ensure you meet the deadline for ordering meals for the following week, which is the Wednesday before the meals are to be taken. **For KS1 children (no payment required), it is advisable to order lunches right up to Easter, to avoid missing a deadline and your child not having lunches provided.** For KS1 children, your meal choices for the following week are only available to view prior to the ordering deadline (Wednesday), so at the time of ordering, it is also advisable to make a note of the meal choices you have made. The deadline for ordering meals for the first week back to school after half-term is NEXT Wednesday 07.02.18.
