History – Ancient Greeks Focus – possible areas to explore

– When was the period of the Ancient Greek civilization? What do the terms modern and ancient mean? What were the key events in Ancient Greek civilization? When, where and why did the first Olympic games take place? How do primary and secondary sources of evidence help us find out about ancient Greek life? What can we find out about the Greek wars? What was the Trojan War? Children to select an area of Ancient Greece that they would be interested in researching for themselves as an independent learning project eg education, childhood, government, food, clothing, arts, sports, famous people, buildings, religion, myths, war, role of men and women, trade, communication, agriculture.

What was life like for the Ancient Greeks and what influence did this have on the western world?

Science – Evolution - Through this unit the children will develop an understanding that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but in many cases offspring are not identical with each other or with their parents and understand that that evolution happens over time, fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth many years ago; how animals and plants are suited to and adapt to their environment in different ways; and how this leads to evolution. Art and Design - Greek Art – Exploring figures and form in movement (linking Greek pottery and the Olympics), sketch work, Work in 3D to explore line, shape, form and texture – wire sculpture models, explore, investigate and experiment with a specific material and technique – clay tiles/pottery, explore techniques and materials used in Ancient Greek Art
