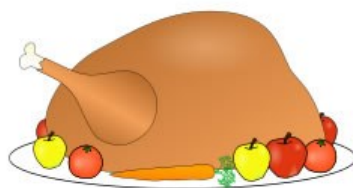
### And What Have We Got Lined Up For Next Week?
