



CHURCHFIELD CHURCH SCHOOL HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT 2016/17

Please read and sign this Home School Agreement which outlines the school's, parents' and children's responsibilities.

The aim of this agreement is to strengthen the partnership between home and school and make clear the respective roles and expectations.

The School will:

1. Ensure the safety, security and physical well being of your child whilst in our care.
2. Ensure your child receives the legal entitlement of a broad and balanced curriculum which is based on their individual needs.
3. Promote high standards and high expectations of effort and attainment using our ASPIRE system to teach behaviour for learning.
4. Teach the children how to follow our PRAISE values.
5. Promote good behaviour by setting clear boundaries and having high expectation.
6. Take all concerns about suspected bullying seriously and act promptly to resolve the issues for all concerned.
7. Provide properly planned, weekly homework opportunities which are realistic, achievable and related to work in school.
8. Provide opportunities for extra-curricular activities.
9. Provide a written report informing you of your child's progress with his/her class teacher at least once per year and provide opportunities for you to discuss your child's progress with his/her class teacher at least twice per year.
10. Promote a partnership with Parents and deal with parental concerns promptly.
11. Keep parents well informed about school life and special events through the Monday Messenger, Texts and the Website.

Parents/Guardians will:

1. Support the aims of the school.
2. Ensure their child attends regularly and on time.
3. Ensure their child wears the school uniform and follows the school dress code.
4. Encourage their child to follow the PRAISE values.
5. Support the school's behaviour policy and co-operate fully with any behaviour procedures should they become necessary.
6. Attend any parent consultations, reviews, assemblies or events which involve their child.
7. Ensure their child completes any homework and returns it on time.
8. Read regularly with their children.
9. Keep the school informed of any changes in circumstances (i.e. address, phone number, emergency contacts etc.)
10. Inform the school of any problems that may affect their child's learning or behaviour.

Children will:

1. Follow the PRAISE values.
2. Work hard and do their best to reach their targets.
3. Show ASPIRE learning behaviours
4. Let an adult know if there is a problem.
5. Complete and return homework.
6. Be prepared for learning
(arrive on time, with the right equipment i.e. PE Kit etc.)
7. 'Own up' if things go wrong.
