

Priorities for Pupil Premium funding 2017-2018:

Item/Initiative	Cost	Aims of spending	Outcomes/Impact
Pastoral Support	£10,500	To support children with social and emotional needs/difficulties to enable them to make good progress across the curriculum.	
Nurture Groups/Forest School	£5,000	To provide children with the opportunity to explore the outdoors whilst building valuable behaviours for learning which can then be applied in the classroom.	
Year 5 and 6 smaller classes for morning sessions - English and Maths	£50,000	To provide additional support for children in the core subjects to enable them to achieve their potential within a smaller group.	
Year 6 and 2 Intervention Groups	£5,000	To provide extra support for those children who need it in the core subjects to enable them to make good progress.	
Year 6 SATS Booster Sessions	£5,000	To provide extra support for children in the core subjects to enable them to achieve in their SATS tests.	
Sports Clubs	£2,000	To provide children with the opportunity to take part in sports activities over and above PE lessons, building confidence and vital skills such as teamwork and gross motor.	
Year 6 Residential Trip	£2,500	To enable children from low-income households to have the same opportunity as their peers in benefitting from the experience of a residential trip.	
Swimming Lessons	£2,000	To enable children from low-income households to have the same opportunity as their peers in attending swimming lessons, thus gaining a vital life skill.	
Speech and Language Sessions with qualified Speech and Language therapist.	£6,000	To provide children with speech and language difficulties with the appropriate support and techniques to enable them to make good progress.	
Milk	£300	To provide children from low-	All children receive milk -

Extra TA provision across whole school	£45,000	To provide extra support in classes for intervention groups to take place to address misconceptions and consolidate learning.

SATS Breakfast Club	£100	To provide all year 6 pupils with a healthy breakfast and positive start to the day during their SATS.	
Whizz Kids Breakfast and After School Club	£1000	To provide some Pupil Premium families with funds to pay for their child to attend breakfast club and / or after school clubso that the parents can go to work.
